We do not intend to transfer your personal data outside the European Economic Area.

You may demand that the Controller provides access to personal data relating to the relevant data subject, and you may rectify, erase such data or restrict their processing; you are entitled to object to the processing of such data, and to transfer such data. You are entitled to file a complaint with the supervising authority, i.e. President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

We shall store your personal data for as long as necessary to achieve a defined goal.

We have acquired your personal data directly from you.

In each case the provision of personal data is voluntary. Your failure to provide the data does not cause any negative consequences for you, however our correspondence related to the matter addressed to us may be hampered or infeasible due to the lack of such data.

Your personal data will not be subject to decisions issued in an automated manner, and will not be subject of profiling.
